Rides last for 1.5 -2 .00 hours from the moment we arrive to the ranch. After a security briefing horse will be assigned and we will begin the ride along the grasslands of the fundo across open ground. Going across green pastures, ancient forest, open ground with views to the mountains in wide trails. Eventually we reach an ancient green forest

where we will be able to learn about the plants and trees, your guide will happily share with you interesting information about

Starts and ends at:
Puerto Varas, at your hotel at 9.30 am and back at 2 pm

Location:

Puerto Varas. Lake District, South of Chile.

Duration:

40 minutes drive from Puerto Varas to the farm, hours the horse 1.30 aprox, this will depend on the riders' experience.

Difficulty level: Easy

Terrain: Open ground, hilly, native forest, with wheat crops according to the season.

Transportation: Private vehicle from your hotel.

Equipment to bring:

Water, warm clothes according to weather and time of the year.

Trekking or trainers shoes, comfortable trousers, rain jacket, sun protection (sunglasses, hat although helmets are provided)

Guide: English, and Spanish is spoken and knowledgeable in native flora and fauna history, geology.

Not Included: Tips, insurance.
